- We netted 330.88 from the July 4th fundraiser. Suggestions for next year: no necklaces, need more water to sell, dunk tank was good- did well, consider selling hot dogs and hamburgers.
- We still have first aid kits to sell, 20 or less left.
- We need to move income to the transportation acct. from the \$330.00 that we budgeted for the boys for summer camp.
- The office supply budget needs to be increased by \$100.00 because of phone costs.
- We have \$1900.00 in the general fund.
- We still have a few boys that owe dues, but we're in good shape.
- On the food handler's course, Aramark covered the cost for 12 people at \$5.00 a piece. The troop will pick up the cost for the 2 extra people that took the course. It will be budgeted from adult training and will be recouped when we make \$ from working the concessions at O.U.
- We got the big size shirts in. Sizes and cost are as follows: XL- 9.00, XXL- 10.00, XXXL- 11.00. We also have 20 hats for 8.00 a piece. We will look into the cost of sweatshirts or fleece shirts.
