



New Procedures for Cascade District Eagle Scout Candidates

We will be discussing the new procedures for future Eagle Scout candidates at the September Roundtable. It is recommended that all District Scoutmasters and Troop Advancement Chairs attend the discussion.

Internet advancement – it's easy, quick and should be done as a check for those troops currently using Troopmaster,

New Life to Eagle packet on the District website – We recommend ALL upcoming Eagle Scout candidate read this shortly after obtaining the Life Rank.

Planning your eagle project? Only Mrs. Johnson and Mr. LaBouy are approved by the District to sign off on Eagle Projects. They will NOT be accepting any project with less than 30 days turnaround time, unless it has been previously agreed to with Mrs. Johnson or Mr. LaBouy. Poor planning on a scout's part does not mean they will be working late Wednesday, Thursday and Friday nights with a scout who is hoping to do a project on Saturday. They do not have a standard list of "quick and easy" eagle project either. Scouts are responsible for finding an eagle project.

Blue cards – copies will need to be submitted with Eagle Scout applications in order to verify ALL merit badge councilors are registered and are authorized to sign off on the merit badge cards. Not sure if you are registered? Please check with the keeper of Cascade District's merit badge list – Lukas VanGinneken. Scouts MUST be signed off by registered merit badge councilors to make have the merit badge be official.

Eagle Scout Application – do you have the updated version? Please check the scout office or online at <http://www.nesa.org/PDF/58-728.pdf>. Old versions will not be accepted after November 1 for new Eagle Scout Candidates.

Eagle Scout Board of Review – forgot your sash? Forgot your project book? Forgot to get the eagle project booklet signed that it was accepted? Forgot to bring adults with you for your Board of Review? You will be turned away at the Board of Review and asked to reschedule at a future date. Plan ahead.
