“Outdoor Webelos Leader Skills” and the “Adult Leaders Outdoor Skills Training” for Boy Scout leaders have been combined to run in conjunction with each other.

There are sessions where Webelos Leaders and Troop Leaders will be learning together as well as separate breakouts for leaders based on the programs they are in.

Who Should Attend:

Recommended for **ALL** Webelos Leaders, Parent, Guardians, and any adult who intends to participate with their Dens in outdoor activities.

Also, **ALL** new & experienced Pack Committee Members who wish to gain a better understanding of the Scouting outdoor program **AND** Cubmasters & Asst. CM's that have not recently received any BSA designed outdoor skills training.

What Will Be Covered:

This is a “hands-on training” to give adults and adult leaders the practical skills necessary to successfully lead their Webelos Scouts in outdoor activities.

Some of those skills include: planning an outing for your Webelos Den, setting up campsites, outdoor cooking, knot tying, whipping ropes, the correct handling of woods tools, using Front-Country Leave No Trace guidelines, putting on an interfaith worship service, setting up campfire programs, and other pertinent skills related to the outdoors.

Leaders will work on the following activity badges: Forester, Geologist, Naturalist, Outdoorsman, and Ready-man. Also, the Webelos-to-Scout Transition process will be elaborated upon.

As Webelos leaders, making connections with Troop and other Scout Leaders will be very beneficial to your Den. The connections you make during the training can be carried forward to Camporee's, Klondike's, and other camping activities that you and Troops can do together.

And, as an added bonus, you will receive the OWLS certificate of completion.
