What made it great?

This trail climbs steeply from Lake Crescent to the WW2 era aircraft spotters lookout on top of Pyramid Peak. 360 degree View of the Solduc Valley, Lake Crescent, Strait of Juan de Fuca and Pacific Ocean. Also, on the north side of the lake is the Spruce Railroad trail following the grade constructed during WW1 to harvest spruce for aircraft construction. Fairly level grade, views of the lake and several tunnels. Trail can be hiked or done by mountain bike. Camping nearby on the west end of the lake at Fairholm campground in Olympic National Park. In summer canoes can be rented from both the Fairholm store on the west end and at Cabin Creek Resort on the east end of the lake.

Location

Lake Crescent in Olympic National Park. West of Port Angeles WA. Trail parking is accessed from the road near the Fairholm store/campground.
