IOLS is the Outdoor requirement for adult Scouters to receive the "Trained Patch" (and to be eligible for Wood Badge training). The other segment, All Leader Basic Training, is offered separately. Whether it's first aid, cooking, tying knots, selecting a campsite, or pitching a tent, we're here to help. The **Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills** training course is being offered at Nobscot Scout Reservation. This course will polish your leadership skills, and help you develop a safe, effective, and challenging outdoor program for Scouts of all ages and skill levels. This is a hands-on course where you will **LEARN BY DOING**. You and other Scouters will form Patrols in an adult training Troop where you will have the opportunity to see the Patrol Method in action on a weekend campout.

The course begins with the Pre-Campout Planning Meeting on Thursday, May 13th from 7:00pm to 8:15pm at Nobscot Scout Reservation White Lodge, where we will form patrols and plan for meals and equipment, etc. From the time you arrive at camp on Friday evening, May 21st, and set up your campsite until you leave on Sunday morning you and your patrol will practice most of the outdoor skills needed to attain the rank of First Class Scout. Some of the most experienced Scouters in the council will be your guides as you practice Scouting skills and share experiences with fellow Scouters.
