### **Policy Regarding Merit Badges and Certifications at Treasure Valley Scout Reservation**

Recently, there has been interest in Scouts returning to Treasure Valley Scout Reservation to complete "partial" Merit Badges, take new Merit Badges or work on certifications including BSA Lifeguard/Mile Swim.

In response, the following shall be in effect immediately.

#### **"Partial" Merit Badges/Certifications**

- Scouts who have made significant progress toward a Merit Badge or certification while attending Treasure Valley during the current Summer Camping season may return that season and finish the badge.

#### **New Merit Badges/Certifications**

- Scouts who wish to start a new Merit Badge or certification and attended Summer Camp at Treasure Valley during the current season must:
  - Have the approval of the Camp and Program Directors
  - Pay the "additional week" fee of \$150

An adult who will assume responsibility for them during the session must accompany them and be at camp during the entire session(s). No Scout may be dropped off and left at camp. Scouts must make prior arrangements with the camp, have the approval of the Camp and Program Directors and that their presence will not interfere with current campers working on badges.

Scouts who did not attend Treasure Valley during the current season must pay the provisional Scout fees.

All fees must be paid prior to acceptance of the Scout and the Scouts are required to have on file with the Health Officer appropriate Medical Information

The Mohegan Council reserves to make adjustments to this policy, as it deems necessary without prior notification.
