Reservation Guidelines

1. Units in a site have until Check Out on Saturday of the week they are in camp to reserve the site they are currently in for the following year.
2. Units may also reserve any open site that is either not being used that week or any non-reserved site in the previous weeks or future weeks.
3. Reservations will not be accepted unless accompanied by the full site deposit fee and completed reservation form.
4. Reservations will only be accepted at Treasure Valley Scout Reservation during the scheduled summer camp. Following the close of the summer camping season, reservations may be made at the Mohegan Council Service Center.
5. Site deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable (to another Troop, Camp Season, or facility reservation).
6. Deposits will be applied to the total fees due for camp.
7. The Mohegan Council, BSA reserves the right to adjust site selection or add a Troop to the site as needed based on size, etc.
8. Units will not be able to reserve a site that is occupied during the desired week until the week is officially closed (12 noon on Saturday)
