Treasure Valley Scout Reservation Closing Policy

Treasure Valley Scout Reservation is a year round camping and activity facility operated by the Mohegan Council, Boy Scouts of America in Rutland Massachusetts. There may be times throughout the year when it may become necessary to close the facility do to severe weather or other conditions beyond our control.

The Camp Ranger and his volunteer staff make every attempt to keep the camp open and available. Treasure Valley Scout Reservation will remain open as long as the Ranger or designee deems roads passable and facility safe and operational. Please remember that weather conditions vary greatly in our area. Severe weather in one section of the council does not mean it is occurring at camp or visa versa.

Should it become necessary to close the camp due to severe weather or other condition, notice will be posted immediately on the council's website (www.mohegancouncilbsa.org), WTAG AM 580, and messages left on the council and camp voice mail systems. Weather conditions may include but are not limited to heavy rain, wind, ice, snow or State of Emergency (as declared by local or state officials).

If the Mohegan Council closes the camp due to the above a credit will be issued to the unit or group renting the facility for future use. Units or Groups canceling their outing while the camp is open may be subject to the existing refund policy.
