### Registration

Registration is by pack only. Your Pack's Camp Coordinator should go to NCAC's website (below) to register. Fees are \$140 if paid on or by April 10<sup>th</sup>. Then \$160 if paid on or by May 22<sup>nd</sup>. Thereafter, fees are \$185 per boy. Go to

**PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY – LOTS OF DETAILS!**  
(Please photocopy and distribute to Den Leaders, parents, etc.)

**Attention Goose Creek Scout families! We have a couple of people signing on to help with camp, but to host 200 boys at camp we need LOTS of help! We are still on the lookout for staffers for shooting sports, crafts, Science/nature, sports, games, first aid, tot lot, den time, and our special programs. We need EVERYTHING!**

**If you're interested in working on staff for the full 5 days of camp (aka "Staffers")** -- Please fill out the paperwork for your son, but you will not have to pay for his fee. This is to avoid the problems that always seem to occur in getting refunds. PLEASE REMEMBER, STAFF IS **NOT** THE SAME AS A WALKING DEN LEADER. STAFFERS STAY IN AND RUN A PARTICULAR PROGRAM AREA OF CAMP AND TAKE TRAINING TO BE ON STAFF. IT IS A DISTRICT LEVEL DAY CAMP POSITION. Walking den leaders, even any that attend with their packs for the full week, are there as a function of their own pack program, and do not receive a free registration.

**Shooting sports staff** -- Certification (BBs or Archery) is required. NCAC has scheduled training for these in April.

**First Aid staff** -- requires minimum of Red Cross first aid and CPR training. We can't hold camp without this staff. If you have this training, are a nurse, EMT, or more, please consider staffing in this area.

**Junior staff** -- must be 14 and up to be considered "staff" and are eligible for a \$75 voucher for Goshen or service hour credit (BSA, private schools, church/synagogue/mosque, NHS). Younger Scouts can work in camp, but are not considered staff and are not eligible for the Goshen discount. The Goshen discount can be used for this summer or rolled over into next summer (2010). Many Scouts, even those 14 and up, opt to work camp as service, and do not take the credit. You should not claim both. Please pass this along to Boy Scouts or Girl Scouts that might like to help. Anyone who has worked Day camp will tell you that they definitely have served and worked hard! We have youth work every year, not for the Goshen credit, but because they like to give back. Please make sure they all have the chance!

**All staff positions require local staff training**, usually held here in Goose Creek district in May, and takes about 1/2 day. All Staff will be required to be registered adults with BSA. Parents who are not currently registered with their packs as leaders or committee members, who will be working staff, are encouraged to fill out your adult application with your packs now. Or you may choose to register through the district as a member of the district at large. Registration at the pack level, however, benefits your pack. Many packs pay for the adult registration fee, as you will be giving time to your pack as an available adult helper.

**By the way, staffers do not HAVE to be members of Cub Packs or even have a boy attending.** We will take Troop leaders too! Or if you know of someone who has the time and qualifications and likes to work with kids, please send them our way. We would also like to have on our staff folks with expertise in and access to the aerospace industry to help with our Space theme.

**If you cannot work a full week of camp, but can staff an area for part of the week, please email me!** We may be able to pair you with another adult to cover a station. This is often something that can work well especially in the first aid or tot lot areas.

**Tot Lot** – a great help to our staffers! If you'd like to volunteer, but have potty-trained preschoolers too young to attend Camp, considering placing them in our Tot Lot while you work at Camp. This special program is available only to our volunteers and staffers.

**Siblings** – Scouting-age brothers (and sisters!) of current Cub Scouts are welcomed to register for and attend camp right alongside Scouts! Incoming Tigers may register and attend, too!
